NOTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998) (“NEMA”) AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) REGULATIONS, 2014 FOR THE PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE EXISTING SPORT COMPLEX ON PORTION 3 OF FARM NO. 566, HAWSTON, WESTERN CAPE.

Guillaume Nel Environmental Consultants (GNEC) has been appointed to facilitate the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Basic Assessment for the proposed expansion of the existing sport complex in Hawston, Western Cape.

Proposed development:

It is proposed to expand the existing sport facility to the western side of the existing facility.

The entire area applied for is approximately 23 000m². The need is for the development of a soccer field within this area. The entire area is applied for should there be a need for additional future developments of sport related infrastructure within this section.

The priority will be the development of the soccer field; approximately 8214m² in size.
